PUBLIC SAFETY PROFESSIONALS WHO HAVE COMPLETED A COML, COMT, OR INTD, COURSE MUST COMPLETE A SERIES OF COMPETENCY TASKS IN THEIR PTB AS THE NEXT STEP IN BECOMING A CREDENTIALED COML, COMT, OR INTO IN IOWA. IN THIS ONE-DAY EXERCISE, TASKS ARE DESIGNED TO SIMULATE CHALLENGES COMMUNICATIONS UNIT TRAINEES WILL ENCOUNTER DURING AN INCIDENT. TRAINEES ATTEND ONE DAY OF THIS EVENT FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE DISCIPLINE.

AT THE END OF THE EXERCISE, RECOGNIZED EVALUATORS CAN SIGN OFF ON TASKS WITHIN THE PTB FOR TRAINEES WHO HAVE SUCCESSFULLY DEMONSTRATED THEIR PROFICIENCY AT COMPLETING THE TASK(S). ALL TASKS MAY NOT BE COMPLETED BY ALL TRAINEES AT PROFICIENCY.
