Welcoming Remarks: Chair Bischof welcomed everyone and thanked them for attending.

Approval of Agenda: Cindy Heick motioned to approve today's agenda. Travis Solem seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion passes.

Approval of Minutes: Travis Solem motioned to approve the January 2023 ISICSB Meeting Minutes. Curtis Woten seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion passes.

SWIC Report: SWIC Haley Nichols reminded the group that the SCIP Workshop will take place following today's ISICSB Meeting.

SWIC Nichols reports that the annual SPOC/DPS Legislative open house was held on January 17, 2024. Herself and Chair Bischof were on hand to meet with legislators and answer questions about ISICS and future needs of the system.

SWIC Nichols, Scott Richardson, Shawn Page, and Gabe Starling gave a presentation regarding ISICS at the State Fire School. Topics of discussion included the ISICS system, usage and best practices, and a use case involving a Tama County incident. A panel was then held to answer questions. The 3-hour course was well received.

Regarding the REMCDP grant, SWIC Nichols reports the following:

- Visits were made to Carroll County St. Anthony Hospital and Manning Hospital to discuss implementation of products from the grant
- Meeting with Calhoun County soon
- Temp/part-time grant assistant position offered to retired DPS Cpt. Mark Miller he will start with DPS on 3/1/2024

SWIC Nichols reports she has submitted a notice of interest to apply for the 2024 Homeland Security Grant project to provide cybersecurity for the ISICS system. The application was advanced to the application process, which was completed on 2/7/2024. SWIC Nichols will keep the Board updated.

Regarding the West STR deployed to Dickinson County for Winterfest, Luke Erpelding reports that all went well, and the generator ran for 93 hours and used just shy of ½ tank of fuel. Arrangements are being made to get the generator serviced due to its regular schedule.

Disaster Recovery PSAP was deployed in Palo Alto County in January 2024, as the PSAP was moving. The Central STR trailer and 22 cache radios were on hand for the INTD course held in West Des Moines earlier in the month.

SWIC Nichols gave praise to the Board and the great work that has already taken place in 2024, especially in regards to policy/standards review per the schedule created by the Governance Committee. There has also been an uptick in Committee Member applications Committee involvement.

911 Council Report & E911 Program Manager: 911 Program Manager Blake DeRouchey reports the following:

- Reviewed the 911 Program financials
- Approved two training fund requests:

- NENA Spring Conference \$5,000 "Training is a Team Sport"
- Polk County/Westcom \$10,800 "How to Save a Life"

User Group Committee (UGC): UGC Chair Hess reports the Committee met and reviewed two new user applications that are up for approval today under New Business.

Finance Report: SWIC Nichols reports the monthly net expenditures for January 2023 for the Interoperable and Broadband Communications Fund were \$14,452.44. The remaining amount available is \$131,176.18.

Governance Committee: Governance Committee Chair Ness reports the Committee met and discussed the use case for additional encryption.

Operations Committee: Operations Chair Edson reports the Committee met and has been working to get a better understanding of what the specific needs are for discipline-specific encryption for interoperability talkgroups. The Committee continues to collect information and is looking at the option of working at the sub-regional level, as the requests have come from agencies that are in Region 1.

Training & Outreach Committee: Training & Outreach Committee Chair Solem reports the Committee met and discussed the following:
