# Russian Military Cyber Actors Advisory

- Released by FBI, CISA and NSA.
  - Assess that cyber actors affiliated with the Russian General Staff Main Intelligence Directorate (GRU) are responsible for computer network operations against US and global targets for espionage, sabotage, and reputational harm since at least 2020.
- Mitigation strategies:
  - Prioritize system updates & remediate known exploited vulnerabilities.
  - Segment networks to prevent the spread of malicious activity.
  - Enable phishing-resistant multifactor authentication (MFA) for all externally facing account services, especially for webmail, virtual private networks (VPNs), and accounts that access critical systems.

# Best Practices: Event Logs & Threat Detection

- Released by Australian Signals Directorate's Australian Cyber Security Centre (ASD's ACSC), CISA, FBI, NSA, and other international partners.
  - Increased prevalence of malicious actors employing living off the land (LOTL) techniques – Fileless malware, various downloads, etc.
- The key factors for logging best practices:
  - Enterprise approved logging policy;
  - Centralized log access and correlation;
  - Secure storage and log integrity; and
  - Detection strategy for relevant threats.

# Priority Telecommunications Service (PTS)

- PTS includes:
  - Government Emergency Telecommunications Service (GETS): wireline
  - Wireless Priority Service (WPS): wireless
  - Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP): circuit repair and installation
- Presently voice only. Working on data.
- PTS Dialer app
- Need more than GETS if using cellular
- Priority extends beyond provider network boundaries.

    - Nationwide: 498K
    - Iowa: 3,183 (6.72% of eligible)
  - WPS
    - Nationwide: 973K
    - Iowa: 2,655 (5.61% of eligible)
  - TSP Nationwide
    - 395K
