Welcoming Remarks: Chair Bischof welcomed everyone and thanked them for attending. Chair Bischof announced that there is now a full Board with seven members. Luke Erpelding with DPS Storm Lake State Radio is the new Communications Center representative, and Patrick Updike is now the Member At-Large representative.

Approval of Agenda: David Ness motioned to approve today's agenda. Mindy Benson seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion passes.

Approval of Minutes: David Ness motioned to approve the August ISICSB Meeting Minutes. Curtis Woten seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion passes.

SWIC Report: Deputy SWIC Walser reports the following:

- SWIC Nichols is currently at Central States COMMEX in Joplin, MO
- Reminder to all ISICS users that minimum programming standards include all of the Regional and Statewide Interoperable Talkgroups as well as the 217A – refer to ISICS Standard 1.7.0
- There is a new process for TA requests expected to begin on October 1, 2024 there
 will be 2 request periods per per year in October and April, in which lowa will be able
 to submit up to five TA requests, with no guarantee that all five would be accepted for
 that time period.
- Work continues on review and revision of policies and standards that is happening at the the Committee level; contact SWIC Nichols if you would like to join a Committee.
- Reminder: Channel markers should not be used on interoperable talkgroups
- SWIC Nichols has been made aware of national ransomware attacks daily via CISA reports on healthcare, government, public and private agencies. Be aware this continues to be a threat that could disrupt your daily operations, so have a plan in place for mitigation.

911 Council Report & E911 Program Manager: 911 Program Manager Blake DeRouchey has taken part in a working group to discuss some legislative matters. This was discussed at length during today's 911 Council Meeting, which can be watched at https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=C1B IL-Zjqg.

A meeting with a question/answer discussion with GIS individuals will take place at the end of October.

User Group Committee (UGC): UGC Chair Vandewater reports the Committee met and reviewed two new user applications that are up for approval today under New Business.

Finance Report: The monthly net expenditures for August 2024 for the Interoperable and Broadband Communications Fund were \$15,319.23. The remaining amount available is \$179,063.24.

Governance Committee: Governance Chair Ness reports that the Committee met and continues to review and revise standards and policies.

Operations Committee: Operations Chair Erpelding reports the Committee met and discussed the Medical Interoperable Communications standard that was previously out for 30-day public comment. Based on a few comments received, some of the language has

been changed, and the standard is up again for approval under New Business to be posted for another 30-day comment period.

The Committee also discussed ISICS Standard 1.12.1 – Alert Tones and had a discussion regarding channel markers.

Training & Outreach Committee: No report.

Technology Committee: Deputy SWIC Walser reports that the Committee met once and continues to discuss ISICS Standard 3.11.0 – Talkgroup Site Access and Roaming.

FirstNet Broadband Subcommittee: FirstNet Subcommittee Chair Benson reports the Subcommittee will meet on September 24, 2024, in order to receive an update from FirstNet Authority and AT&T. The FirstNet Authority will also be holding a Response Operations Group demonstration in West Des Moines on September 25, 2024.

<u>FirstNet Authority Update</u>: FirstNet Authority (FNA) Representative Tom Lampe reports the following:

- The Task Force Report for the February 22, 2024, nationwide outage is now available on firstnet.gov website
- FNA Board approved \$2 billion to expand FirstNet and improve coverage will focus on Tribal Nations and rural areas
- 6.1 million users
- 28,500 agencies enrolled in FirstNet
- FNA and AT&T will give a coverage update at the September 24th FirstNet Subcommittee meeting
- Response Operations Group demo on September 25th
