Item 1 - Approval of minutes from POR Board meeting held October 21, 2024

Trustee Conrad made a motion to approve the minutes. Trustee Smith seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 2 - Application for Service Retirement - Todd Koenig

Captain Todd Koenig with the Iowa State Patrol applied for service retirement effective December 6th, 2024. Trustee Conrad made a motion to approve the application for service retirement. Trustee Smith seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 6 – Fee Estimate for the 5-Year Review of the Cancer and Infectious Disease Presumption from CavMac – POR Staff

lowa Code Chapter 97A requires that every five-years an actuarial investigation be performed related to the implementation, utilization, and actuarial costs associated with providing that cancer and infectious disease are presumed to be a disease contracted while a member of the system is on active duty. CavMac has estimated the cost to perform the actuarial investigation to be between \$3,500.00 and \$4,000.00. Trustee Conrad made a motion to direct CavMac to perform the actuarial valuation pursuant to lowa Code Chapter 97 reference the five-year review of the cancer and infectious disease presumption. Trustee Smith seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 7 – NCPERS Annual Renewal of Membership – POR Staff

POR Board Secretary Jasmine Cripps advised that POR received an invoice to renew POR's annual membership with NCPERS for calendar year 2025. NCPERS provides valuable pension news, education, and resources. Staff requested approval to renew the membership and pay the annual

membership dues of \$315.00. Trustee Conrad made a motion to renew the NCPERS membership and pay the annual membership dues of \$315.00. Trustee Smith seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
