**User Group Committee (UGC):** UGC Chair Vandewater reports the Committee did not meet in December.

**Finance Report:** Chair Bischof states that the \$985.06 that was incorrectly appropriated last month has now been re-appropriated.

The monthly net expenditures for December 2024 for the Interoperable and Broadband Communications Fund were \$15,191.53. The remaining amount available is \$112,265.23.

**Governance Committee:** Governance Committee Chair Ness reports the Committee met and continued to review standards and make necessary edits. Standards 7.1.0 and 7.3.0 will be up for adoption in today's New Business.

**Operations Committee:** Operations Committee Chair Erpelding reports the Committee did not meet due to the meeting date falling on the New Year's holiday. The next meeting will be February 5, 2025.

**Training & Outreach Committee:** SWIC Nichols reports the Committee met and continued to discuss the Position Task Book (PTB) training. There was also mention of the upcoming COML and COMT courses as well as the Tri-State COMMEX on June 12, 2025.

**Technology Committee:** Technology Chair Updike reports the Committee met and discussed the ICS 217A and programming the six new frequencies. Chair Updike and the DPS System Administrators demonstrated some of the functionality of the six frequencies. A demonstration was given to show off-network direct radio to radio communication.

**FirstNet Broadband Subcommittee:** FirstNet Broadband Subcommittee Chair Benson reports that the Subcommittee has not yet met this month. The Subcommittee will meet next week, and there will be a presentation regarding FirstNet 5G.

# Other Reports:

<u>Information Sharing Board Members</u>: SWIC Nichols reports that a few DPS communications center personnel were invited to the State of the State address on Tuesday, January 14, 2025. Cpt. Hove states that two communications center managers and four dispatchers will be recognized for their response to the Spencer/Clay County floods.

Legislative Night at DPS will be on Wednesday, January 15, 2025.

<u>ISICS System Administrator Report</u>: Assistant System Administrator Scott Richardson reports the following:

- ISICS Astro ugrade completed now on Astro 2022.0
- Astro system upgrade issues with the Zone 2 DSR switchover
  - A few dispatch and RF sites did not come back online after Zone 2 DSR rollover (Muscatine and Clinton)
  - Cause was determined to have been a core router programming issue the issue has been corrected and resolved
- DPS had a connectivity issue involving some system management tools at the ISICS NOC – issues were resolved by a switch reboot
- Zwingle site has a tower light beacon issue beacon replacement to be scheduled
- Numbers for December 2024:
  - Radios = 42,065 (up 785 from November 2024)
  - o Talkgroups = 3,547 (up 123 from November 2024)
  - Push-to-Talks = 2,809,239 (up 51,217 from November 2024)
