MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD APRIL 20, 2026

The Board of Trustees of the Peace Officers' Retirement, Accident & Disability System convened on April 20, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. Members of the Board present and constituting a quorum were Chairman Stephan Bayens, Trustee Seth Bean, Trustee Mark Oiler (Remote), Trustee Roby Smith, and Trustee Marland Winter. Item 1 - Approval of minutes from POR Board meeting held March 16, 2026

Trustee Bean made a motion to approve the minutes. Trustee Winter seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 2 - Application for Service Retirement – Troy Bailey, Marc Griggs, Kenneth Haut, Ronald Humphrey, David Linkletter, Jagat Sandhu, Matthew Williams, and Eric Young

Vested POR member Scott Holtz applied for vested service retirement effective May 8, 2026. Trustee Bean made a motion to approve the application for vested service retirement. Trustee Winter seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 4 - Application for Survivor Benefits – Linda Voster

Retired Trooper Dean Voster passed away on March 19th, 2026. His surviving spouse, Linda Voster, applied for survivor benefits. Trustee Winter made a motion to approve the application for survivor benefits. Trustee Bean seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 5 - Application for Accidental Disability Benefits – Trent Vileta

The board reviewed the application and requested additional information regarding evaluating and assessing disability applications. Attorney Lundquist provided legal guidance regarding the applicable standards the board should apply in evaluating different types of disability applications. Trustee Winter made a motion to table Item 5 for one month to evaluate the application and supporting documents in light of newly received guidance. Chairman Bayens seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 6 – Application for Ordinary Disability Benefits – Michael Brosnahan

Special Agent Michael Brosnahan applied for Ordinary Disability benefits and was seen by physicians at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics. The recommendation letter from the POR Medical Board was provided to the POR Board of

Trustees for review and action. Trustee Winter made a motion to approve the application for ordinary disability. Trustee Bean seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 7 – Quarterly Performance Report – December 31, 2025 – Treasurer’s Office

Treasurer of State’s Office provided the quarterly performance report for December 31, 2025. Trustee Bean made a motion to accept the quarterly performance report dated December 31, 2025. Trustee Winter seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
