MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD JULY 20, 2026

The Board of Trustees of the Peace Officers' Retirement, Accident & Disability System convened on July 20, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. Members of the Board present and constituting a quorum were Chairman Stephan Bayens, Trustee Seth Bean, Trustee Mark Oiler (Remote), Trustee Roby Smith (Remote), and Trustee Marland Winter. Members of the Board absent were none. Item 1 - Approval of Minutes from POR Board meeting held June 15, 2026

Trustee Bean made a motion to approve the minutes. Trustee Winter seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 2 - Application for Service Retirement – Nathan Teigland

Special Agent Nathan Teigland applied for service retirement effective October 1, 2026. Trustee Bean made a motion to approve the application for service retirement. Trustee Winter seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 3 - Application for Service Retirement – Thomas Clark

Trooper Thomas Clark applied for service retirement effective October 2, 2026. Trustee Bean made a motion to approve the application for service retirement. Trustee Winter seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 4 - Application for Vested Service Retirement – Steven Lamp

Vested POR member Steven Lamp applied for vested service retirement effective September 13, 2026 and elected Option #6, the Joint & 100% Survivor Annuity. Trustee Bean made a motion to approve the application for vested service retirement. Trustee Winter seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 5 – Reappointment of Trustee Mark Oiler – POR Staff

The Governor reappointed Trustee Mark Oiler to serve another 2-year term which runs from May 1, 2026, through April 30, 2028.

Item 6 – Quarterly Performance Report – March 31, 2026 – Treasurer's Office

Treasurer of State's Office provided the quarterly performance report for January, February, and March 2026. Trustee Winter made a motion to accept the quarterly performance report dated March 31, 2026. Trustee Bean seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 7 – Iowa Administrative Code Red Tape Review and Non-Substantive Updates – Director Wittenwyler & Legislative Liaison Josie Wagler

Pursuant to Executive Order 10, POR staff, DPS Legislative Liaison Josie Wagler, and Director Jim Wittenwyler reviewed Iowa Administrative Code sections 400 through 403. The review streamlined the text by removing repetitive language and non-substantive details, such as phone numbers that are available online and subject to upcoming changes. The recommended revisions were provided to the Board. Trustee Bean made a motion to approve the proposed Iowa Administrative Code red tape review and non-substantive updates as outlined by Director Wittenwyler and Ms. Wagler. Trustee Winter seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Item 8 – National Conference on Public Employee Retirement Systems – POR Staff

POR staff provided the Board with information related to an upcoming NCPERS Public Safety Conference in October and requested the Board's approval to attend the conference. Trustee Bean made a motion to approve POR staff attending the NCPERS Public Safety Conference. Trustee Winter seconded. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

POR Board Secretary Jasmine Cripps advised the Board an application for accidental disability was received for Special Agent Robert Sanky. An update will be provided after the medical records are submitted to the POR Medical Board.
