Minutes of Meeting Held January 18, 2022

Item 1 - Approval of minutes from POR Board meeting held December 20, 2021

Item 2 - Application for Survivor's Benefits – Mary Longseth

Retired Trooper Neil Longseth passed away on January 7th, 2022. Neil retired from the Patrol in July of 1980 and is survived by his wife, Mary Longseth. Mary has submitted a completed application for survivor's benefits. Staff recommends approval of survivor's benefits for Mary Longseth. Trustee Conrad made a motion to approve the survivor's benefits. Trustee Metzger seconded. Motion carried.

Item 3 - Application for Accidental Disability – Trooper Justin O'Rourke

Trooper Justin O'Rourke with the Iowa State Patrol has submitted an application for POR accidental disability benefits and was seen by physicians at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics on December 15th and 17th, 2021. The recommendation letter from the POR Medical Board is put before the POR Board of Trustees for review and action. Trustee Conrad made a motion to approve the application for accidental disability. Trustee Metzger seconded. Motion carried.
