Chair Stoldorf called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

CP Stoldorf asked the Board members to introduce themselves and ES Young welcomed Luke Maloney, a new Board member that filled the Building Official position.

CP Stoldorf asked public members, who joined by phone, to introduce themselves.

CP Stoldorf moved to the first item on the agenda, which was the approval of the meeting minutes from May 20, 2021. Black made a **motion** to **accept the minutes as written**. Cooling **seconded** the motion. 7 Aye, 0 Nay. All in favor; motion carried unanimously.

The next item on the agenda was the report of the Executive Secretary.

ES Young reviewed the financial report, which was previously provided to the Board for their review, and directed the Board's attention to revenue and expense items.

The next item on ES Young's report was the civil penalty letters for electricians working without licenses. Those individuals receiving civil penalty letters were: *Justin Guler, William Osborn, Duncan Wood, Zeke Blondell, Alec Skuball, Mitchel Elkin, Jesse Johnson, Tyler Kriegel, Ashton Masias, Nicholas Sharp, Austin Winch & Alexander Kruser*. VC Cash made a **motion** to **approve the letters**, and Maloney **seconded** the motion. 7 Aye, 0 Nay. All in favor; motion carried unanimously.

ES Young moved to the next agenda item which was an update on ARC 5587C (rules for licensing felonies HF 2627, relaxed rules for licensing out-of-state electricians, military spouses and exam pass percent scores). ES Young stated the last reading of the rules were passed on July 13, 2021 and that the new rules go into effect on August 4, 2021.

ES Young turned the meeting back over to CP Stoldorf.

CP Stoldorf called for public comment. Dan Beeding asked about progress in regard to exam score being lowered to 70% from 75%. ES Young stated this was approved through ARC 5587C and will go into effect on August 4, 2021. ES Young also stated that the rule allows those who have set for the exam within 24 months prior to August 4, 2021 and received a score of 70% to 74%, can submit a license application to the Electrical Examining Board. CP Stoldorf asked if the Board's staff will reach out to past test candidates in that timeframe with corresponding scores, to which ES Young and Secretary Cindi Hayes will collaborate.

The next item on the agenda was Other Board Business. ES Young stated that the next board meeting will be September 16, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. ES Young also requested all Board members to submit their travel expenses for FY 21, within the next week to him.

VC Cash made a **motion to adjourn**. Claeys **seconded** the motion. Chair Stoldorf called for the vote, 7 Aye, 0 Nay. All in favor; motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 10:14 a.m.
