#### **Risk Management at Every Level:** Understanding the Risk and the Roles Officers & Chief Officers Play

We have all heard of "risk management" in the form of assessing risk versus benefit on the fire ground. But does it stop there? Risk management is an ongoing effort to maximize results and minimize loss. From the fireground to the fire station, your officers should be using risk management to keep you personnel safe and satisfied. In this presentation we will discuss the responsibilities of being a risk manager as an officer.





Chief Holt serves as the Fire Chief for the Urbandale Fire Department where he has been the Chief for since 1998. He has been an EMT since 1980 a paramedic since 1985, and is currently an instructor for the Fire Service Training Bureau.

Sam Peterson will discuss the new ISO Mitigate website, as well as a quick overview of the hauled water program and the differences between that grading and a solely hydrated grading.




Sam Peterson
